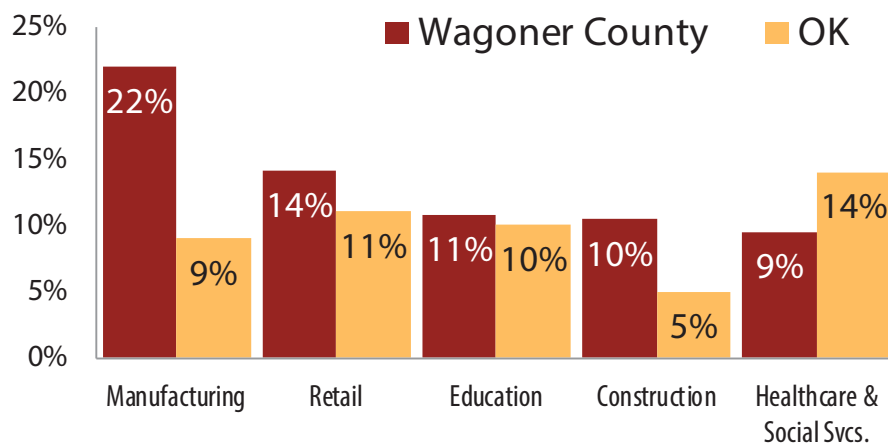

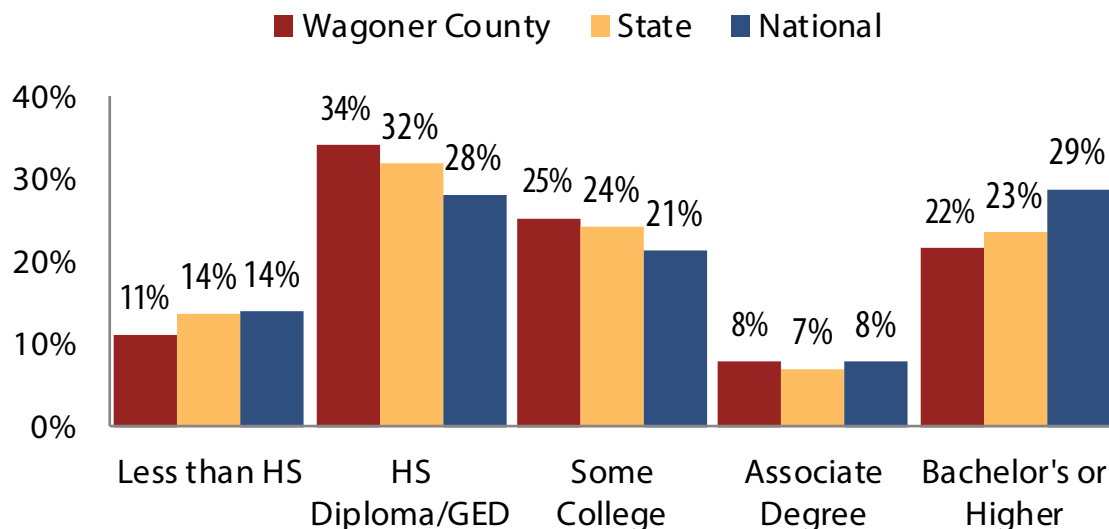
**Top 5 Employment Sectors**
